- Were not admitted into <u>competitive admission programs</u> or missed application or acceptance deadlines




# WHAT IS EXPLORATORY STUDENT ADVISEMENT? (ESA)

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## **CONTRACT TERMS**

- Enroll in courses approved by Advisor
  - All changes must also be approved
- Complete the Success Certificate (see next slide)
- Complete the UNIV 101: Saluki Success course
- Meet with your 1) Saluki Success Coach, 2) Tutor or Academic Coach; 3) and Academic Advisor on a regular basis
- Honor SIU's Student Conduct Code
- Regular attendance and completion of coursework is required!







# REQUIREMENTS FOR DECLARING YOUR MAJOR

 GOOD ACADEMIC STANDING = 2.0 GPA\* (on 4.0 scale) after two standard semesters in SSI

- Earn your **SUCCESS CERTIFICATE**, samples include:
  - 1. Attend at least **6 WORKSHOPS**.
  - 2. Participate in at least **1 COLLEGE SPOTLIGHT** event related to your major or interest.
  - 3. Attend weekly **ACADEMIC COACHING SESSIONS**.
  - 4. Complete at least **10** sessions at the **TUTORING CENTER** or **WRITING CENTER**.
  - 5. Participate in at least **1 ACCOUNTABILITY GROUP** session (**2** sessions = **1** workshop).

\*Some special admission programs may have additional steps.



The Dr. Seymour Bryson Future Scholars program serves newly admitted students in the Saluki Success Initiative program for the summer and fall semesters. Students accepted to the Future Scholars summer program will take classes during the last 4 weeks of the summer semester in the month of July for **FREE**.

#### Students are given a chance to:

- Get an early start to their college career
- Register for summer and fall classes early
- Experience summer residence on the SIU campus with dining options included
- Attend classes 5 days a week and enrolling in up to 7 hours of University Core Curriculum courses
- Attend mandatory study table for tutoring and academic coaching services
- Learn about and explore campus resources early
